Bushfire Counselling Service

The BUSHFIRE SUPPORT COUNSELLING SERVICE is free and run by Catholic Care, the office is at the Monaro Family Support Service, Sharp St Cooma and outreach service is available by arrangement. Counselling is provided for children, adults, families, couples; anyone who has been impacted by the bushfires. It is not uncommon for people impacted by the fires to show signs of distress or needing support for up to several months or years after the event. It is important for us to look after ourselves and seek professional help when feeling overwhelmed, experiencing ongoing stress and distress as a result of our experiences during the bushfires.

This service helps you to deal with the emotional reactions of disbelief, stress, anxiety and grief. It can support you to make a plan for moving forward and offer coping strategies, social supports, counselling and family-based psychological interventions. The program delivers evidence based and trauma informed therapeutic services. Sessions are also available via telehealth services. Contact 0488 111 646 to make an appointment and find out more.
